GETTING TO BEAUMANOR

Please note: County Hall minibus transport option not available for this course

- See the Contact page of our website for directions. Our postcode is LE12 8TX.
- Park in the main Beaumanor car park between 8.45 and 9.00am, then follow the 'Holiday Club' signs to the base room to drop your child off.
- Park in the main Beaumanor car park after 4.45pm, then follow the 'Holiday Club' signs to collect your child. We aim to be finished each day by 5:00pm.
- If you are late collecting your child there will be a charge of £5 per child for each 15 minutes, or part thereof, that you are late. If you pick up your child after 6.00pm you will incur a charge of £10 per child for each 15 minutes, or part thereof.

IMPORTANT

Each child will be allocated a number and the person leaving the child will be given a token with the number corresponding to their child. ONLY the adult with this token will be permitted to collect their child in the afternoon.

COST

The cost is £210 per child for the week. This is fully inclusive of all activities and transport to off-site venues. Please note that lunch is not included and children should bring their own packed lunch and a drink.

WHAT WILL CHILDREN NEED TO BRING?

- · Packed lunch and drinks
- Suitable activity clothes (due to the nature of activities clothes may get dirty or damaged)
- Trainers/walking boots (no open toe shoes or sandals)
- Change of clothes, a towel and a plastic bag for any wet clothes
- Sun cream and sun hat (for sunny weather)
- Any medication your child requires (with name on medication)
- A small amount of money for the gift shop (optional). Please note that the gift shop does not sell food or drink.

Please do not send your child with mobile phones and other electronic gadgets as we cannot be responsible for loss or damage. If any child is found with a mobile phone or other electronic gadget it will be confiscated and returned at the end of the day.
