#### **Activities in Detail**

All activities are run by experienced and highly qualified staff. The activities are designed to promote team working and to build confidence and to encourage children to try new activities whilst making new friends along the way.

### **Archery and Survival**

Using the superb woodland in Beaumanor Park you can learn basic survival skills, build your own woodland shelter and enjoy the warmth of campfire. This is experienced in combination with the thrill of archery where you can test your own 'eye for a target'. We have both indoor and outdoor ranges.

## Canoeing

Situated at the picturesque Watermead Country Park you will take part in a full day of Canoeing activities. The morning will consist of basic strokes on the lake before setting off in either tandem or rafted canoes for a journey on the river. Lunch will be taken at an appropriate stopping point on the way.

# **High Ropes Course**

A great way for children to work together helping each other over this fun and challenging course. The courses you choose will include a mixture of different elements so please check the descriptions before you book. For this day children need to be at least 1.15 m tall.

**Aerial Trek**: Have you got a head for heights? Test your nerve as you walk along ropes and poles 9m above the ground. A great way to challenge your agility and hand/eye co-ordination.

Crate Stack: In your small team try to construct the highest possible crate tower beneath you.

**Leap of Faith:** One of the most daring challenges of the High Ropes Course! Climb a 9.5m pole, balance on top of a small platform and launch yourself into the air on a trapeze bar! Face your fears whilst your team members cheer you on.

**Zip Wire:** Enjoy a thrilling ride on a 150m zip wire from the top of an 11.5m tower.

Ultimate Challenge Day Come and test your problem solving skills, and become part of a successful team. The day will include a variety of mentally and physically challenging activities, designed to push you to your limit. These may include elements of the High Ropes Course, Climbing & Abseiling, Archery and much more. Finishing with a grand finale activity in the afternoon.
